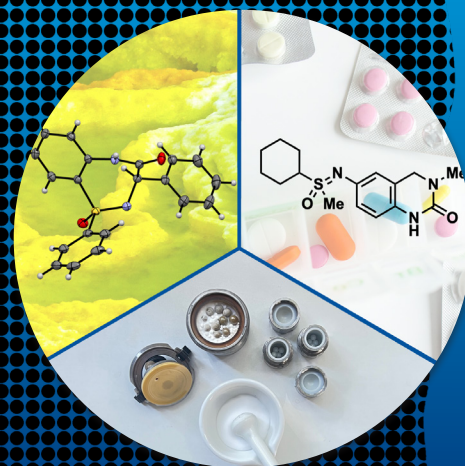

Bolm studied chemistry at the TU Braunschweig from 1978, graduating in 1984 (with Henning Hopf). In 1983/84 he was also at the University of Wisconsin-Madison on a Fulbright scholarship, where he received a Master's degree in chemistry under Hans Reich. From 1985 he was in Marburg, where he received his doctorate in 1987 with Manfred T. Reetz (chiral catalysts for enantioselective C-C linkages). In 1987/88 he was a post-doctoral researcher with Barry Sharpless at MIT and then in Darmstadt and Basel with Bernd Giese, with whom he habilitated in 1993. In 1993 he became Professor (C 3) of Organic Chemistry at the Philipps University of Marburg and in 1996 C4 Professor at RWTH Aachen University. He was awarded with e.g. 1991 Heinz-Meier-Leibnitz-award, 1998 Otto-Bayer-award, 2015 Adolf-von-Baeyer-Denkmünze (GDCh). 2015 he became Fellow of the Royal Society of Chemistry.

Since 2022 he is elected to the Academia Europaea.
